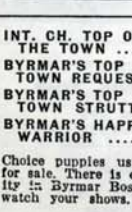

BOSTON ASPECTS

The Editor of DW, in line with the policy of keeping the magazine in "live wire" contact with what breeders actually are thinking, presents this series of "breed aspects" and herewith, written at the Editor's request, is a statement from **MRS. CLAUDE FITZGERALD**, bostons, 1806 Eureka, Wyandotte, Mich.

1. Why I chose my present breed? For its companionship, short hair, watch dog, and gentleness with children.

2. Is the breed going up or down? To my way of thinking the quality is definitely getting better, due to change in standard on gait, making for soundness; demand for sales run to small dogs; smaller bitches have smaller litters; registrations go down.

3. Suggested changes in the present breed standard, if any. Disqualify for showing all cryptorchid and monorchid dogs, as either one of these dogs is unsound.

4. General remarks and comments on breed matters. There is no reason why we cannot have 3 pt. shows at all breed shows, by eliminating the 3 pt. wins in groups and each exhibitor bring two instead of one dog, if interested in their breed. Under the present system it is possible for a dog or bitch to complete its championship without ever beating another animal in its own breed; its two three-point shows should definitely be won in its breed; this would without question make our champions of higher quality and therefore improve the breed.

More sincerity in people accepting judging assignments for breeds THEY DO NOT KNOW.

LIABILITY OF POLICE OFFICERS IN KILLING OR IMPOUNDING DOGS

There is a twilight zone between the liability and nonliability of a police officer for killing a dog.

owner's premises and remove a dog unless he has a court order or warrant.

Where an officer goes out of his way to seize a dog or arrest a dog owner, without due process of law, and with malice on his own part, an action for damages will lie against the officer personally.

A public official who kills a dog supposed to be diseased but not actually so, is liable (29 N. E. 854). However, he is not liable for injuries inflicted necessarily while he was exercising due care (170 S. W. 231).

No law is valid which authorizes the killing of a dog unless the killing is justifiable to safeguard the public against injury or loss of property (144 Ind. 2798).

However, a public official performing government functions (as differentiated from purely ministerial functions such as maintenance of roads, for example) can not by his wrongful act, hold his employer, the city or otherwise, liable for damages (74 N. W. 111, 20 S. E. 653, and 130 Ill. 238). The public official personally may be liable in these cases but not the governing body.
